FRAUD ALERT

Police in the Scottish Borders are issuing a warning to the public after an elderly female was contacted by a male attempting to defraud her of money by suggesting that an attempt had been made to fraudulently remove funds from her account and asking her to go to her bank and transfer funds immediately to a different account. This seemed like a legitimate Bank telephone number but it wasn't.

TV LICENCE SCAM

If you receive an email stating it is from TV Licensing asking you to click on a link to process a refund – **don't do it.** It is a scam. Always be wary of any type of email that claims you are due a refund or need to transfer money between accounts. These are sophisticated scams known as Phishing that are made to look genuine with logos etc. If in any doubt do not reply to the email but contact the company directly by phone and check with them. WARNING FROM A RESIDENT CHRISTMAS PARCEL SCAM

A local resident has suggested that we alert you to a Christmas scam that seems to have resurfaced this year again. It's the one where you get a card through the door saying there is a parcel that couldn't be delivered to you and advising you to phone the number on the card to arrange delivery.

It is a scam and if you phone the number, could result in a ± 300 phone bill.
