A6091 BGH ROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

DROP-IN SESSION, TAKING PLACE TUESDAY 23rd JANUARY between Noon and 8pm

The Ormiston Institute, Market Square, Melrose TD6 9PN is the venue for a drop-in session for residents, businesses and other members of the community interested in the forthcoming A6091 BGH road safety improvement scheme. You will gain information about the scheme and the new traffic control system, and have an opportunity to speak to the engineers responsible for developing the scheme.

The works will begin on Monday 5th February 2018 for six weeks, to improve road traffic safety on the A6091 (a route used by around 11,400 vehicles each day), at the junction with Borders General Hospital. A new traffic lights system at the junction will make it safer for road users making right or left turns and a new 'hurry on' system will allow a faster entry/exit for ambulances.
