WEAK BRIDGE WARNING – KALEMOUTH SUSPENSION BRIDGE

Residents are requested to **comply with the 3 ton weight restriction** which applies to Kalemouth Suspension Bridge. It has been noted that some vehicles which exceed this limit are using the bridge which has caused some deterioration most likely caused by vibration. A full bridge inspection is now required. If the weight restriction continues to be ignored it may be necessary to reduce the weight limit on the bridge further meaning that it may be closed for access to lighter vehicles.
